APPLICATIONS

STORAGE & HANDLING

Due to its flash point of 11°C, this solution is classified as a highly flammable liquid and must be stored in a cool, well-ventilated area away from ignition sources. Proper containment is critical to prevent the accumulation of toxic vapors and to maintain the integrity of the reagent by protecting it from moisture and environmental contaminants.

- Store in a cool, dry place away from heat sources.
- Use HDPE or glass containers for storage to avoid chemical reactions.
- Keep away from strong oxidizers and acids.
- Ensure proper ventilation when handling to avoid inhalation of vapors.
- Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) including gloves and goggles.
